7. Accreditation

Competitors shall undergo an accreditation process (5 €) before the weigh-in. One team representative must attend the accreditation on Friday, February 09, 2018 from 10:00 to 17:00 in order to confirm the delegation attendance.

Passports or photocopies of passports from all participants must be available on request (national ID card is also accepted).

8. Deadlines

9. Weigh-in

Official weigh-in will be held before the competition day (please see Program).

Athletes are not allowed to weigh-in naked.

Athletes must present their accreditation cards and passports (national ID cards showing the nationality and date of birth are also accepted).

Random weight checks of 4 (four) athletes per weight category (except for the "+" categories) with the same rules as the official weigh-in can be organized before the first fights in the morning of the competition. The athletes must present their accreditation cards. The weight of the athlete cannot be more than 5% higher (without his/her judogi) than the official maximum weight limit of the category.

10. Tournament Format

The tournament will be conducted in accordance with the latest IJF SOR and IJF Refereeing Rules.

The tournament system according to the number of participants.

11. Tournament Draw

The draw will take place on Friday, 09 February, at 19.00 and on Saturday, 10 February, at 20.00.

The top eight (8) from the entered competitors in each weight category will be seeded according to the current IJF World Ranking List.

12. Refereeing

Each federation may enter 1 referee. The organizing federation may enter as many referees as required for the realization of the tournament. The requirement in refereeing is at least the highest national licence and some years of experience as a referee.

The Referee Meeting will be held **on Friday**, **09 February**, **at 17.00** (please see Program). The attendance to the Referee meeting is strictly compulsory. The referees should be dressed formally for this meeting.

Bowing:

- * The contestants must not shake hands BEFORE the start of the contest.
- * When the athletes are leaving the mat they must be wearing their Judogi in the proper way and must not remove any part of the Judogi or the belt before leaving the FOP (Field Of Play).

Special Refereeing Rules for boys and girls:

- Application of kansetsu-waza is allowed and should continue until maitta, tapping the mat twice or if the contestant is incapacitated by the effect of kansetsu-waza.
- Application of shime-waza is allowed. An athlete who has lost consciousness due to shime-waza is not allowed to continue the competition.

13. Coaching

All coaches must fully adhere to the Code of Conduct for Judo Coaches.

Dress Code

Draw: Lounge suit and tie

Eliminatory rounds: National track suit with trousers

reaching down to shoes or lounge suit with tie

Final block: Lounge suit with tie

14. Judogi Control Approved Judogi

All Judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi.
