

5. Participation

The YURTOV CUP International Judo Tournament among boys and girls is open for national and local teams, clubs. There is no limit in the number of participants for each weight category.

6. Weight Categories and Duration of Rounds

2002-2003 Birth Year:

Girls: -44, -48, -52, -57, -63, -70, +70 kg

Boys: -50, -55, -60, -66, -73, -81, -90, +90 kg

2004-2005 Birth Year:

Girls: -40, -44, -48, -52, -57, -63, +63 kg

Boys: -42, -46, -50, -55, -60, -66, -73, +73 kg

Duration: 4 minutes Golden Score

7. Accreditation

Competitors shall undergo an accreditation process (10 €) before the weigh-in. One team representative must attend the accreditation on Friday, 03 May 2019, from 10:00 to 17:00 in order to confirm the delegation attendance.

Passports or photocopies of passports from all participants must be available on request (national ID card is also accepted).

In the event of competition reentry among those born in 2004, the entry fee shall be repaid.

9. Weigh-in

Official weigh-in will be held before the competition day (please see Program).

Athletes are not allowed to weigh-in naked.

Athletes must present their accreditation cards and passports (national ID cards showing the nationality and date of birth are also accepted).

Random weight checks of 4 (four) athletes per weight category (except for the “+” categories) with the same rules as the official weigh-in can be organized before the first fights in the morning of the competition. The athletes must present their accreditation cards. The weight of the athlete cannot be more than 5% higher (without his/her judogi) than the official maximum weight limit of the category.

10. Tournament Format

The tournament will be conducted in accordance with the latest IJF SOR and IJF Refereeing Rules.

The tournament system depends on the number of participants.

11. Tournament Draw

The draw will take place on Friday, 03 May, at 19.00 and on Saturday, 04 May, at 20.00.

The top eight (8) from the entered competitors in each weight category will be seeded according to the current IJF World Ranking List.

12. Refereeing

Each team may enter 1 referee. The organizing federation may enter as many referees as required for the realization of the tournament. The requirement in refereeing is at least the highest national licence and some years of experience as a referee.

The Referee Board is not an appeal body. Referees may consult with it in the event of any difficulties. Participants or delegation representatives under no circumstances shall refer to the Referee Board. Appeals against Referees' decisions won't be accepted.

The Referee Meeting will be held **on Friday, 03 May, at 17.00** (please see Program). The attendance to the Referee meeting is strictly compulsory. The Referees should be dressed formally for this meeting.

Bowing:

- * The contestants must not shake hands BEFORE the start of the contest.
- * When the athletes are leaving the mat they must be wearing their Judogi in the proper way and must not remove any part of the Judogi or the belt before leaving the FOP (Field Of Play).

Special Refereeing Rules for boys and girls:

- Application of kansetsu-waza is allowed and should continue until maitta, tapping the mat twice or if the contestant is incapacitated by the effect of kansetsu-waza.
- Application of shime-waza is allowed. An athlete who has lost consciousness due to shime-waza is not allowed to continue the competition.

Withdrawal from the contest due to injury

In the course of preliminary rounds:

- If it is impossible to determine which of the contestants is responsible for the injury, the injured contestant shall lose the contest.
- If the responsibility for the injury is attributed to one of the contestants, the other contestant shall be declared a winner. The contestant responsible for the injury is not allowed to participate in consolation rounds.
- In case of withdrawal, the contestant is not allowed to participate in further contest.

In the course of finals and semi-finals:

- If it is impossible to determine which of the contestants is responsible for the injury, the injured contestant shall lose the contest.
- If the responsibility for the injury is attributed to one of the contestants, the other contestant shall be declared a winner.

Direct Disqualification (Hansoku-make)

In the event of direct disqualification (Hansokumake) due to the actions that violate the spirit of Judo, the Referee Board takes a joint decision. In this case, the Judoka shall not receive a medal and ranking points for this competition.

Note: A contestant who has lost due to the injury is allowed to continue the competition. A contestant who has been given direct disqualification is not allowed to continue the competition.

13. Coaching

All coaches must fully adhere to the Code of Conduct for Judo Coaches.

14. Judogi Control

Approved Judogi

All Judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi.

Please note: It is strictly prohibited to promote tobacco, alcohol, using advertising spaces.

15. Transportation

According to Decree of the President of the Republic of Belarus No. 8 On the establishment of visa-free entry and exit procedure for foreign nationals dated 9 January 2017 as amended on 24 July 2018, the visa-free entry to Belarus is available to nationals from 80 countries travelling only through Minsk National Airport for a period of not more than 30 days.

Decree of the President of the Republic of Belarus No. 462 dated 26 December 2017 establishes visa-free entry procedure for foreign nationals travelling to the Republic of Belarus through the State Border of the Republic of Belarus with the Republic of Poland at the Bruzgi checkpoint (Kuznitsa Belostotskaya), Grodno railway checkpoint (Kuznitsa Belostotskaya), with the Republic of Lithuania at the Privalka checkpoint (Raigardas) and temporary stay for tourism purposes within a period of up to 10 days in the territory of the Avgustovsky Canal and adjacent areas (including Hrodna).
